GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

Built for transport of military equipment (capacity is 170 TEU or 25 trucks). Operated by State Enterprise for Water Transport (Iraqi Line) until 1990. Arrived 14/7/1990 at Bremerhaven for engine refit after engine troubles during voyage from Jeddah to North Europe but was arrested later due to the UN embargo against Iraq. Laid up at Bremerhaven since then without any work done yet. Watchkeeping crew of 2 sailors is onboard permanently. Intention of new Iraqi government reported to set the vessel in operation again for € 6.0 mio seems unlikely.
