The ANGELES and ANGOL (2,797 teu) join CLAN

German owner NSC Schiffahrt has received the 2,797 teu ANGELES and ANGOL, last two units in a series of eight ships ordered by this owner in the first quarter of 2005 at the Zhejiang Yangfan Shipbuilding Group. The two ships have been chartered by CLAN (subsidiary of Maruba) for assignment to the Maruba-CLAN stand-alone service connecting East Asia to the ECSA and WCSA.

Lomar Shipping is believed to have purchased the 2,797 teu sister vessels ANGOL and ANGELES for about USD 10 M per ship.

Both vessels are currently on charter to Great White Fleet (GWF - the shipping division of the Chiquita fruit group) and deployed between Central America and the US East Coast.

The ANGOL and ANGELES were both built in 2010 by China's Zhejiang Yangfan Shipping Group based in Zhoushan. They feature a deadweight of 35,400 tons, a Loa of 224 metres and a beam of 30.50 metres.

The ships have a capacity of 738 reefer plugs and are of gearless configuration. They belong to the 'Zhejiang 2800' series of ships of which eight units were built from 2007 to 2010.

Transfar Shipping buys the WINDSWEPT (2,797 teu)

Singapore-based Transfar Shipping has purchased the 2,797 teu WIND-SWEPT (Zhejiang 2800) from Lomar Shipping for a reported USD 52 M. Lomar is making a huge profit on the transaction, having bought the vessel early in 2021 for only USD 10 M. According to Alphaliner, the WINDSWEPT is the very first container vessel bought by Transfar who had been so far only chartering tonnage.

The WINDSWEPT was built in 2010 in China by Zhoushan-based Zhejiang Yangfan Shipping Group, originally as the ANGOL for Hamburg-based NSC Schiffahrt. The vessel features a deadweight of 35,400 tons, a Loa of 224 metres and a beam of 30 metres. She is fitted with 638 reefer plugs.
