2017:

Navios to buy Rickmers Maritime containership fleet while Rickmers Group to restructure

Greek dry bulk and containership owner Navios Maritime Partners L.P. will acquire the remaining containership fleet of Rickmers Maritime, the Singapore-based shipping trust which is being wound up after failing to secure a restructuring agreement with its creditors.

14 containerships of 3,400 to 4,250 teu, with an average age of 9.5 years will be acquired for \$113 M by Navios Partners, who will finance the acquisition through a \$20 M equity investment and a secured loan facility.

The acquisition remains subject to a number of closing conditions, with an initial fleet of five 4,250 teu units chartered by MOL to be transferred in mid-May and the remaining nine ships expected to follow in the following weeks. Four of the ships are currently laid up.
