1983: **The PCTC m/v ARABIAN BREEZE with the capacity of 3,242 cars was built in 1983**

1994: **Acquired by Wallenius Lines in 1994**

2007: Norwegian stocklisted equipment supplier **TTS Marine has won a contract to fit life-extending features on four elderly car carriers belonging to Wallenius Marine**. TTS will fit new watertight bulkhead doors on all of the four Wallenius ships to increase damage stability and to effect compartmental separation. It will also refurbish the ro-ro equipment onboard each ship and reinforce the stern ramps to manage heavier loads.

The first of the ships, the 3,070-car BALTIC BREEZE (built 1983), is already moored at the Cosco outfitting quay in Dalian where work will continue until March. The second ship, the 3,070-car AEGEAN BREEZE (built 1983), will also be upgraded at Dalian, starting early May. **The final ships were not specified though Wallenius has two other 1983-built sisterships from Shin Kurushima, the ASIAN BREEZE and the ARABIAN BREEZE.**

2008 **ARABIAN BREEZE went through a major refurbishment and modernization** which made the vessel more efficient and sound for at least 10 more years in service. ARABIAN BREEZE is chartered by UECC for short sea operations in Europe.
