Newport SA has Transocean Maritime Agencies panamax in

[tradewindsnews.com](#) — Newport SA, a low-profile Greek company, is believed to be close to acquiring its fourth bulker in 16 months. Brokers in Athens and London said the George Chatzis-led company has purchased the **76,900-dwt Ascanius (built 2004)** from Transocean Maritime Agencies. It is believed to be fetching between \$8.5m and \$8.7m. The price tag falls within the \$8.2m to \$10.2m range estimated by VesselsValue and Maritime Strategies International for a ship of the Ascanius' characteristics.
