GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

The car carrier which ran aground on the Codling Bank is expected to be moved into Dublin Port in the morning. Oil from the stranded vessel has been transferred to a tanker in order to lighten the vessel before it is towed off the bank. The Panama-registered Asian Parade was carrying 1,700 cars, and 150,000 gallons of fuel oil. Fortunately, the Codling Bank, where the car carrier is aground, is sand and gravel, so extensive damage that could cause pollution is unlikely.
