# **MOL** makes it six

Mitsui OSK Lines (MOL) has ordered another large ore carrier on the back of more long-term business from China's Baoshan Iron & Steel (Baosteel).

The order for the 225,000-dwt ship has gone to Japan's Namura Shipbuilding and will be delivered by early 2012 at the latest.

The new vessel will carry ore from Western Australia to Shanghai under a 25-year contract of affreightment starting in June 2007.

This is the sixth COA deal between MOL and China's largest steel maker which last month said it will increase annual ore purchases by 90% by 2012.
