**GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:**

Navios Maritime Holdings Inc. a large, global, vertically integrated seaborne shipping company, announced today that it has acquired all of the outstanding share capital of Kleimar N.V. for cash consideration of \$165.6 million, subject to certain cash adjustments.

Kleimar is a Belgian maritime transportation company established in 1993. Kleimar has 11 employees and is an owner and operator of capesize and panamax vessels.

Kleimar currently controls 12 vessels, of which it has ownership interests in three. One of the owned vessels will be sold as a result of the change in control. The long-term chartered-in fleet consists of five capesize vessels, chartered-in at an average daily rate of \$17,477, three panamaxes, chartered-in at an average daily rate of \$12,109, and one handymax chartered-in at \$7,950 per day.

The average age of Kleimar's controlled fleet is 3.0 years.

Kleimar also has purchase options on two capesize vessels, the **BEAUFIKS** (2004 built) and the **Fantastiks** (2005 built), exercisable for an average price of \$35.7 million during the first quarter of 2008. These purchase options are substantially in-the-money based on current capesize valuations for forward deliveries.
