GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

1987: Delivered to Deutsche Seereederei in a series of four vessels all named after East German socialist politicians. Employed as **WILHELM PIECK** on the TRICON service between Europe and Asia provided with POL.

1990: Renamed **BRANDENBURG** enbloc with 3 sister vessels when GDR East Germany merged with FRG West Germany.

1998: All vessels were sold to Maritime Consortium Sdn. Bhd., Malaysia.

BRANDENBURG has been trading as **MONTREAL SENATOR** with sister vessel MSC INDONESIA (ex- OTTO GROTEWOHL) in MSC's Capricorn service between Australia and Asia (port rotation: Fremantle, Jakarta, Singapore, Laem Chabang, Singapore, Jakarta, Fremantle)

2003: Vessels were sold en bloc to Costamare Shipping Co. S.A., Greece.
(AK ..& 09+10/2003)

2006: Temas also bought two other vessels the MV **MONTREAL SENATOR** priced US\$ 10,625,000-changed to **STRAIT MAS** and MV BUDI WAJA (US\$ 9,875,000) to RIVER MAS. But up to 2007, APL will charter both vessels for its regional services.
