In Brisbane, Australia, Hamburg Süd named another 1,819 TEU container vessel, the **CAP PASLEY**. Like the CAP PALLISER, which was christened in Tauranga, New Zealand three days ago, the **CAP PASLEY** is one of a series of five identical charter vessels owned by the Claus-Peter Offen shipping company that are to be deployed in the Hamburg Süd Group's liner service between Asia and Australia/New Zealand.
