Post-panamax boxships sold to Embiricos with charter-back deals

TROUBLED French container line CMA CGM has sold a trio of post-panamax boxships for \$35m each to Greek owner Embiricos.

The vessels were the 2001-built, 6,712 teu **CMA CGM Ravel** and 2001-built sister vessels of 6,627 teu, the **CMA CGM Bizet** and **CMA CGM Debussy**.

The deal includes a charter-back to sellers for three years, with an option for a further two years at \$25,000 per day, London broker Gibson reported.

"This is a very firm price compared to the sale earlier this month of a quintet of NYK-controlled, late-1990s built post panamax units for \$19m each," Gibson said.

2021:**Costamare buys the AGIOS MINAS (6,734 teu)**

Fast expanding Costamare Shipping continues to buy tonnage and is now adding two further ships to its fleet, the 6,734 teu AGIOS MINAS and the 5,908 teu ZANTE which it has purchased from Monaco-based International Maritime Enterprises SAM at an undisclosed price.

Both ships have reportedly been fixed on five-year charters to Maersk and are expected to be renamed PORTO CHELI and PORTO KAGIO respectively.

The AGIOS MINAS was built in 2001 in South Korea by the Daewoo Okpo shipyard, originally as the CMA CGM RAVEL for French carrier CMA CGM.

She features a deadweight of 79,400 tons, a Loa of 300 metres and a beam of 40 metres. She is fitted with 500 reefer plugs.

The vessel is part of the 'Daewoo 6700' series of which 16 ships were built between 2001 and 2004.
