Purchased by ADG Shipmanagement GmbH, Germany/Latvia (Malta flag). Operated under several charter contracts, e.g. as CCTL HULL for Cargo Connect Transport & Logistics Ltd., Hamburg. Operated as SEA TRADER in the Baltic Sea and between Antwerp & Mediteranean ports as well.

AK Jan/Feb 2005

Fire broke out 16/7/2004 on the main deck when a lorry caught fire during loading at Quay 222, Antwerp. Firefighters were in attendance but fire was allowed to burn out in order to avoid capesizing the vessel if too much water pumped on board. Beyond economical repair and has been sold to Ghent for demolition. She was towed from Antwerp 16/9/2004 and arrived Ghent the same day.

Report by Marine News 9/04

The burned out SEA TRADER was purchased by Van Heyghen in Gent for scrap and left Antwerp in tow bound for Gent. SEA TRADER arrived in tow of the tug SCHELDE 10 and assisted by the tug LIEVEN GEVAERT in Terneuzen enroute Gent where the Sea Trader will be scrapped.

Half-scrapped wreck of 8,454gt. Malta-flagged M/V Sea Trader (built 1976) -- sank in Canal of Terneuzen in Gent on June 29. Tugs M/V Hendrik 3 & M/V Hendrik 5 tried to stabilize foundering hulk -- ship now lying half-sunken at the quay -- had burnt out in Antwerpen July 16, 2004 in Antwerpen -- fire extinguished only days later.
