This new bulk carrier joins the Setaf-Saget fleet in the context of a still highly buoyant freight market. With her 55 000-tonne deadweight capacity, her 40-tonne cranes and 18 m3 grabs, the Dalior constitutes the pinnacle of the latest generation of super handimax carriers, pending their replacement by the future 60 000-tonners, already in the blueprints of several yards. As of delivery, the DALIOR set out on her maiden voyage , carrying coal between Japan and Indonesia. Sister vessel is MESSIDOR.
