The Indian Navy released the below two image showing damage to the Marshall Islands-flagged *Genco Picardy* after it was [struck by a Houthi attack drone](#) in the Gulf of Aden on Wednesday. The attack resulted in the a small that the Master reported was extinguished.

The photos are the first to show damages from Yemen-based attacks by the Houthis since November.

The *M/V Genco Picardy* is a Supramax bulk carrier owned by U.S.-based Genco Shipping (NYSE: GNK).
