Shanghai-based Hudong-Zhonghua Shipyard delivered the 147,000 m3 LNG carrier **DAPENG SUN** to China LNG Shipping (International) Ltd for service between Australia's North West Shelf and China's first LNG receiving terminal in Guangdong Province. It is the first of a five ship series that are being dual classed by ABS and China Classification Society (CCS). Keel laying for the first ship took place in June 2005. Construction is already nearing completion on the second in the series, the DAPENG MOON scheduled for delivery in late-June, with the fifth and final ship expected to be handed over one year later in June 2009.
