Norway's Nortechs FPSO has awarded a US \$11 million contract to Pan-United Marine Limited (PUM) to convert the **EAST FORTUNE** tanker into an FPSO. Nortechs is focusing on smaller field developments. The East Fortune FPSO will be ready to produce oil 3Q 2007. After the conversion, the East Fortune will have a production capacity of 30,000 barrels per day and a storage capacity of 360,000 barrels.
