Sinokor buys tankers for double-hull conversion

South Korea's Sinokor Merchant Marine has upped its investment in conversions with another two projects.

The company has reportedly acquired the 151,000-dwt tanker *Front Maple* and 149,000-dwt *Front Birch* (both built 1991) for conversion into double-hull units.

The ships were bought at a reported \$81.6m en bloc.

The pair is the fourth and fifth vessel Sinokor has bought for conversion purposes since last year.
