1997: Troubled Korean shipping company Halla Merchant Marine is pulling out of its charter obligations with some owners as it tries to put together a survival package. Halla is also scheduled to take the 73,000-dwt bulker GREAT GLORY on time charter from Sinomarin following delivery from Halla Engineering and Shipbuilding in January. But the owner is now sounding out the market for a possible sale, indicating that its charter agreement with Halla Merchant Marine has fallen through. Sino Marine, part of the giant Chinese Sinotrans group, is said to be asking USD 30m for the ship, but brokers say that is way above the market price.
