GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

1998: **In collision 11/2/1998 with fishing vessel ALASKA-1 north off Dutch Harbour, Alaska when on passage from Oakland for Taiwan with 4000 containers. A preliminary investigation by the U.S. Coast Guard indicated that the HANJIN BARCELONA had the right of way.** The ALASKA-1 sank subsequently after the collision. All 33 crewmembers boarded two liferafts and were taken to another fishing vessel. (World Maritime News - 13 & 20 February 1998)

2005: Korea's Hanjin Shipping has finally concluded the sale of two more of its early 1990s-built 4,000-teu ships to Greek owner Tsakos Shipping & Trading. **Tsakos has taken control of the HANJIN BARCELONA (built 1992)** and HANJIN TOKYO (built 1994) with a seven-year charter back to Hanjin. The Tsakos-bought ships are to be **renamed HANJIN ELISABETH** and HANJIN IRENE , according to BRS-Alphaliner. They are deployed on the transpacific PSX loop.

These were the first boxship disposals by Hanjin since late 1997, when the then cash-strapped company sold 19 ships as a result of the Asian financial crisis.

HANJIN BARCELONA & HANJIN TOKYO sold en bloc to Greek buyers for US\$ 45 mio both units. Sellers are Hanjin Shipping, South Korea. (www.cotzias.gr - Jan 2005)
