CMA CGM swoops on CONTI 7,500 teu pair

CMA CGM has purchased two 7,471 teu container vessels from Germany-based Conti Reederei in a move to take advantage of the appealing prices in the second hand containership market.

The French carrier has bought the 7,471 teu, 2005-built CONTI VENICE and CONTI LE HAVRE (Hyundai 7500) for a reported \$14.5 M each.
CONTI VENICE has already been renamed CMA CGM INDUS, and the CONTI LE HAVRE should be renamed soon. It is not yet known where this tonnage will be deployed by CMA CGM although the carrier's Far East-West Africa 'ASAF' service as well as its 'PEX 3' eastbound Round-the-World service appear as likely deployment options.

Both the CONTI VENICE and CONTI LE HAVRE were built by Hyundai Heavy Industries (HHI), South Korea, in 2005. They feature a deadweight of 93,541 tons, an Loa of 300 m and a beam of 42.80 m (17 rows). They are fitted with 500 reefer plugs.
