## **GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:**

2014: CNAN-Nord's owned fleet still includes four German-built Trampco' class general cargo vessels built in 1976-1978, the 8,190 dwt DJORF, DJURDJURA, IBN KHALDOUN II and IBN SINA II. The ships are presently laid up in Algeria and offered for sale. The four 8,190 tdw cargos vessels put up for sale by CNAN are among the last surviving examples of the successful 'Trampco'

type, imagined some 45 years ago by German ship designers. A total of 35 'Trampco' ships was built from 1969 to 1978 in different versions, with deadweights of 7,500 to 8,000 tons and container intakes of 179 to 254 teu.

Of these tweendeckers, 33 units were produced by two German shipyards working in tandem: Schlichting Werft of Lübeck-Travemünde and Orenstein & Koppel at Lübeck City. The yards built 22 ships for German owners and 11 vessels for CNAN, while two more units were built in South Africa for local company Unicorn Lines. While most of the 'Trampco' ships have been disposed of for scrap, many of them enjoyed longer than average lives (35 years) thanks to their good design and sturdy construction.
