**GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:**

Maersk Sealand is reinforcing its commitment to the New Zealand market with a faster service to the United States east coast. The Danish operator of the world's largest container shipping fleet was cutting Los Angeles from the route and replacing chartered vessels with its own to cut transit times and increase capacity.

It will join a vessel-sharing agreement already operated by P&O Nedlloyd, ANZDL, Columbus and Fesco to serve the US west coast. Maersk will run the Jens Maersk, **JOSEPHINE MAERSK**, NYSTEAD MAERSK and Nexoe Maersk on the Oceania service to the US east coast. It calls at New Plymouth, Timaru and Tauranga.

Maersk Line commenced trial fortnightly calls to Wellington from 22nd September 2003 in their service to U.S. east coast ports when Nysted Maersk (27,733 gross, built 2001) called to land empty containers for positioning. She arrived from New Plymouth and sailed for Timaru.

Other ships on the service are Nexo Maersk (27,733 gross tonnage, built 2001), Jens Maersk (30,166 gross tonnage, built 2001) and **JOSEPHINE MAERSK** (30,166 gross tonnage, built 2001).
