# **GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:**

Seatrans operated both as a feeder line and as a European sea transport organisation with three time-chartered vessels: m.s. Smaragden, m.s. Klenoden and m.s. Passaden. Their container capacity is 374 TEU and they have the highest Finnish ice class:
