#### **GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:**

SINGAPORE-BASED Advance Container Lines (ACL) is launching a new container feeder service called, Vietnam North Asia. The new service will feature two strings, one of which will be an express service that links Ho Chi Minh to Hong Kong and will be known as "HHX". The second loop will connect Haiphong to Hong Kong and Chiwan in mainland China. This string has been named the Haiphong/North Asia Express or HNX for short.

The HHX will use one MOL vessel, the 590-TEU MOL Accuracy, while ACL will operate the HNX service with the 380- TEU "KOTA MUTIARA".

The port rotation for HHX is: Hong Kong (Sat/Sun), Ho Chi Minh (Catlai, Wed/Thurs), and back to Hong Kong (HIT).

The port rotation for the HNX is: Hong Kong (HIT, Sun/Sun), Hong Kong (MTL, Sun/Mon), Haiphong (Chua Ve, Wed/Thurs), Chiwan (CCT, Sat/Sun), returning Hong Kong (HIT, Sun/Sun).

The HHX service is scheduled to commence on March 25 from Hong Kong, while the HNX is expected to begin next month, departing April 5 from Haiphong.
