GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

Eastern Mediterranean's 88,272-dwt tanker **LUCKY LADY** (built 1981) briefly ran aground off the Indonesian oil port of Cilacap spilling part of its cargo. The single-hulled ship "touched bottom" whilst approaching the berth at the port on the southern side of the island of Java. Reports put the spill at just over 1,000 tonnes. The Maltese-flagged tanker sustained damage to a starboard tank, which resulted in the oil spill. The ship later berthed and is undergoing further inspections. Reports say the Lucky Lady was carrying 80,000 tonnes of crude oil from Seria Terminal in Brunei when the incident happened. The tanker has a good port state control record.
