In December 2012, Sea Consortium purchased the 2,800 teu JENAZ from Renens (Switzerland)-based Suisse Atlantique. The vessel, a 'Hyundai 2800' type built by the Hyundai Mipo yard in South Korea in 2006, was renamed X-PRESS EUPHRATES and is currently deployed on the X-Press Feeders-Simatech Middle East Gulf-West India relay service (NMG).

MSC buys X-PRESS EUPHRATES (2,824 teu)

MSC has bought the 2,824 teu X-PRESS EUPHRATES (Mipo 2800) controlled by Singapore-based Sea Consortium, for an undisclosed price.

The ship is expected to be renamed MSC CAPETOWN III. She will be the 11th 'Mipo 2800' operated by MSC, and the ninth owned by the Geneva-based carrier.

The X-PRESS EUPHRATES was built in 2006 in South Korea by the Hyundai Mipo shipyard in Ulsan, originally as the JENAZ, for Swiss owner Suisse Atlantique. The ship has a deadweight of 39,200 tons, a Loa of 222 metres and a beam of 30 metres. She is fitted with 586 reefer plugs.
