2013: Diana Containerships has sold the 1989-built 4,206 teu panamax containership MAERSK MADRID for demolition for \$8.8 M. The vessel was acquired in in April 2011 for \$22.5 M, under a sale-leaseback deal with Maersk with a two year charter at a daily rate of \$21,450 less a 2.25% commission. Maersk did not exercise an option to extend the charter for another year at \$25,000/day. Panamax ships like the MAERSK MADRID face poor employment prospects, with charter rates at only \$7,000-\$9,000/day currently. (Source: Alphaliner 17/2013)
