Eyal Ofer's Zodiac Maritime has sealed the purchase of a pair of containerships from Germany's Offen Group, market sources say. London-headquartered Zodiac secured the 8,845-teu SANTA LAURA (built 2006) and SANTA LIVIA (built 2007) in a deal which sets a new low benchmark price for containerships of this size.

A price upwards of \$29m en bloc is understood to have been paid for the pair, which VesselsValue says were worth around \$44.5m each at the start of 2016.

VesselsValue today placed the Santa Laura at \$15.70m and the Santa Livia at \$18.85m.

Zodiac's 8,400 teu acquisitions backed by long term Maersk charters

Two 8,411 teu vessels that London-based Zodiac Maritime recently purchased from Hamburg-Based Claus-Peter Offen have secured a long term employment with Maersk Line. The SANTA LAURA and SANTA LIVIA, renamed S. LAURA and S. LIVIA, have been fixed by the Danish carrier for a minimal period of 3 years extendable to five years at a rate of \$13,750 per day. It is believed that this charter was arranged simultaneously with the vessels' purchase.

Both ships were built in 2006-2007 by South Korea's Daewoo (DSME) shipyard. They are part of the 'Daewoo 8000' class of ships, of which 23 units were built from 2005 to 2010.

MSC has broken this week the symbolic threshold of 300 second-hand ship acquisitions, with the recent purchase of no fewer than six more vessels.

These are the 8,411 teu MAERSK SURABAYA (Daewoo 8000), the 5,570 teu MAERSK YAMUNA (Imabari Millenium), the 5,364 teu sisters EVER UBERTY and EVER UNIFIC (Evergreen 'U' class), the 4,506 teu CO NAGOYA (Samsung 4000) and the 4,045 teu POHORJE (CSBC 4000).

The MAERSK SURABAYA was bought from the AP Moller group for a price said to be in the low-USD 40 M. The vessel was built in 2006 in South Korea by the Daewoo DSME shipyard, originally as the SANTA LAURA, for Hamburg-based CP Offen.
