Developed a severe list 6/9/2007 when rain water entered the holds off New Mangalore. Two tugs went to her assistance and she was beached at Tanneerbavi in position 12.53N, 74.49E. The crew remained on board, excess water was pumped out and cargo redistributed and she was refloated 13/9/ on the high tide. An inspection showed some hull damage. She was bound from New Mangalore for China with 16.000 tons of iron ore.
