**GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:**

The Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) has responded angrily to an International Transport Workers Federation (ITF) claim that it failed to help the crew of a Singapore-registered ship abandoned in Vietnam. The Singapore-owned bulk carrier **WAN LING** was arrested in Ho Chi Minh City in July last year and its 24-member crew left stranded there since then. The ship flew the Singapore flag until December when it was deregistered because of safety deficiencies.
