2010: Large vessels continue to be sought after with two of the largest charter market ships without employment, **the 4,953 teu SUNNY AMAZON (ex MOL MAAS) and SUNNY OASIS (ex MOL RHINE), returning to active service in the last two weeks after more than 16 months in lay up.** The two ships have joined Evergreen for assignment to its Far East-Middle East AGP service. **They were laid up in Feb-Mar 2009 for MOL account until the pair was sold and delivered to Korean interests in June 2010.**

Mitsui OSK Lines (MOL) of Japan has sold two 19-year-old units. The 4,800-teu SUNNY OASIS and SUNNY AMAZON (both built 1995) are reported to have gone to India for a firm \$523 per ldt, or \$12.3m, each.
