GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

Bergen based chemical pool operator Seatrans is near to signing a deal with Camillo Eitzen & Co to buy the 19,700-dwt chemical carrier Mont Blanc (built 2000) for \$33m.

Eitzen wants to dispose of the vessel as it is rather larger than other vessels in the fleet of its Navale Francaise subsidiary so its trading pattern is less than optimal. But the purchase makes good sense to Seatrans as the vessel already trades in its Seatrans Erfemer Tankers pool which operates nine vessels, ranging in size from 6,700 dwt to 19,500 dwt. The sale of the Mont Blanc is the latest of a hectic series of transactions by Norwegian shipowner, Axel Eitzen, but most have involved ship purchases or corporate takeovers rather than disposals.
