In January, the TRADE COSMOS returns from its one-voyage charter to DSR-Senator Line but according to Lu Zhongren, president of Sinotrans' operations in Hamburg, it's still too early to phase the vessel into the China-Europe service. That means the vessel will probably be chartered out for another period.

They include the 3,200-teu ALVA STAR (built 1994), the 2,500-teu pair TRADE APOLLO and TRADE COSMOS (both built 1994), the 1,226-teu LA BOHEME (built 1987) and 1,095-teu sisters ABSALON (built 1984) and ALTER EGO (built 1985) and the 1,429-teu CORONA (built 1983).

Aponte is paying higher prices than chartering owners can afford, say brokers, but they add that it will be a shrewd move for MSC if, as expected, charter rates continue to rise next year and freight rates also increase sharply.
