Both German owned -- Cyprus-registered M/V Smaland, in ballast, & Antigua-registered M/V Nikar G, for Poland with paper pulp, in collision off E. coast of Swedish island of Gotland in good weather at daytime with 8 NM visibility -- on both ships Master was watchkeeping officer -- 2 of Smaland's crew in forward section died instantly -- rescue team cut through mangled bulkhead to forepeak, found a 3rd crew died of injuries. Ships' bows damaged -- both remain afloat. (Sat. April 27 2002)

Cargo M/V Nikar G -- ran into the embankment of the Kiel Canal close to Audorf Jan. 28 -- following cargo M/V Askö was unable to stop & ran into the ship. The canal traffic was completely stopped until the situation was cleared. At 11 a.m. M/V Nikar G refloated & able to proceed to Kiel. (Mon. Jan.29 2007)
