2003: There was the sale en bloc of 7 single-hulls: 'CRUDE SUN' / 'CRUDE SKY' / 'CRUDE TRANSPORTER' / 'CRUDE STAR' / 'CRUDE MED' / 'CRUDE TARGET' & 'CRUDE TRAVELLER'. They were part of one of the biggest transactions of the year, for a total of \$517.0 million, consisting of 18 ships of which the 7 Suezmax single-hulls, 6 Suezmax double-hulls and 5 Aframax. 2004: **Frontline has** now additionally **picked up** three (3) Genmar-controlled single-hull Suezmaxes "**GENMAR TRANSPORTER**", "GENMAR TRAVELLER", AND "GENMAR CENTAUR" all about 149,000 dwt built 1989/90/90 Split for an en bloc price of \$66.3m. (www.galbraiths.co.uk)

2008: Ocean HeavyLift said today that Songa Ancora has informed it that due to severe weather in China and shipyard delays the newbuild vessels ANCORA & HAWK will not be delivered on time. Songa Ancora is selling the newbuild vessels ANCORA & HAWK - to be renamed the HEAVYLIFT ANCORA & HEAVYLIFT HAWK - to Ocean HeavyLift. Ocean HeavyLift has accepted that the cancelling date under the memorandum of agreement is extended and that the reduction in price by \$60,000 per day continues until final delivery date. The delay to the HAWK also carries a \$60,000 per day price reduction.
