The ships were ordered speculatively at DSME in two stages in May / August 2007. The first of them, NORTHERN JAVELIN, presently lies alongside at the yard, almost completed, while the second one, NORTHERN JASPER, is also close to completion. The ships delivery is however expected to take place in July-August.

They were to become the first VLCS delivered without commitment to any carrier. MSC thus emerges as the White Knight for these ships which otherwise would have lied at anchor as soon as delivered.

The eight 8,411 teu newbuildings are chartered from German shipowner Norddeutsche Reederei Schuldt (NRS) for the duration of one year, with an option for a further year, at a reported USD 10,000 (USD 12,000 for the optional year).

Norddeutsche Reederei Schuldt (NRS) has received the 8,411 teu NORTHERN JAGUAR, fourth of a series of eight 8,411 teu ships ordered in May and August 2007 at DSME (Daewoo) by this owner. The NORTHERN JAGUAR is to join her charterer MSC, for assignment to its Far East-Med 'Tiger' service. MSC chartered the NORTHERN JAGUAR as part of a deal which may involve up to all of the eight ships, although on different conditions.

Simatech charters a 8,800 teu vessel - its largest ever container ship

Dubai-based Simatech has fixed the 8,814 teu NORTHERN JAGUAR, the largest container vessel it has ever taken on charter. The ship, controlled by Hamburg-based Norddeutsche Reederei H. Schuldt, has been fixed for a period of 10-12 months at \$17,900 per day. It is unclear yet where Simatech will deploy the vessel, but a possibility could be on the FE-Indian Sub Continent route where the carrier operates a joint service with Evergreen, TS Lines, K Line, Hapag-Lloyd, Yang Ming and PIL on which vessel capacities are being gradually upgraded from 5,500 to 8,000 teu.

The fixture of the NORTHERN JAGUAR is undoubtedly a milestone in the relatively young history of the Dubai carrier. Based on Alphaliner records, the largest container vessel chartered so far by Simatech was a substantially smaller vessel, ie the 6,039 teu, Lomar Shipping-controlled LOS ANGELES TRADER which the company fixed in the spring 2016.
