GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

2014: Chinese domestic liner operator Quanzhou An Sheng Shipping Co (QASC) continues to boost its fleet of 4,000+ teu panamaxes, purchased from German owners. After the acquisition in November and January of the 4,298 teu CONTI TIANJIN (built in 2006) from Conti Reederei (renamed REN JIAN 10) and of the 4,713 teu HLL ATLANTIC (built in 2002) from Hanseatic Lloyd (renamed REN JIAN 9), it has recently **purchased the 4,298 teu CONTI GALAXY** (built in 2006) from Conti Reederei. The vessel has been renamed REN JIAN 8 and is to join QASC's China's domestic network.

The CONTI GALAXY was built in Korea by Hyundai Heavy Industries (HHI) in 2006. She was initially chartered by NYK for eight years at a daily rate of \$33,000 (trading as NYK GALAXY). She was redelivered by NYK to Conti Reederei in mid-November 2013 and had been idle in the Far East until her sale. (Alphaliner weekly newsletter 24/2014)
