# Fredriksen sells VLCC trio to Larsen's ADS Crude Carriers

Tycoon's Ship Finance is investing in the sector newcomer which is lining up a Merkur Market listing.

John Fredriksen's Ship Finance International has emerged as the seller of three VLCCs which opened the door to the sector for ADS Crude Carriers.

(The vessels were: FRONT PAGE - renamed ADS EAGLE / FRONT SERENADE - renamed ADS SERENADE / FRONT STRATUS - renamed ADS STRATUS).



Norway's ADS Crude Carriers has reduced its fleet to two following the sale of scrubber-fitted 2002-built VLCC ADS Stratus.

ADS fetched a price of \$25.5m for the vessel, significantly higher than the \$24.51m value placed on it by VesselsValue. According to a post on social media by parent company Shiphold, the sale was at a \$3m premium to the price paid for the vessel in 2018.

Delivery to the new owners, who were not named, is scheduled for around September 17. (https://splash247.com - September 10, 2020 )

# Tankers in sanctioned trades using names of previously scrapped ships

Names of scrapped vessels are being used by several PDVSA (Petroleos de Venezuela SA) customers, including National Iranian Oil Company (NIOC), to disguise the routes and identities of the tankers they use, reports *Reuters*.

A very large crude carrier (VLCC), identified in PDVSA's loading documents as the **Ndros**, arrived at Venezuela's main oil port of Jose last week to load 1.9m barrels of heavy crude, bound for Asia, the documents showed. Except the Ndros was scrapped in 2018, according to satellite evidence from vessel-monitoring service TankerTrackers.com and data on international shipping databases.

TankerTrackers.com used satellite imagery and photographic comparison to identify the VLCC as Liberia-flagged **Calliop** (IMO 9248485). *Reuters* said that it could not independently verify that as the tanker's real name, because the hull had been painted black before its arrival at Jose.

Marine Traffic puts the vessel as out of range since November 21st, when it was en route from Taiwan to Bonny in Nigeria.

Hong Kong-based Ship Management Services Ltd bought the Calliop in October, according to shipping databases showed, but could not be reached for comment.

2002-built, Liberia-flagged, 156,916 gt Calliop is owned by Oderand Shipping SA care of Hong Kong-based Ship management Services. While it had been previously listed as being covered by Gard, it no longer appears on Gard's web site as an insured vessel.
