### GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

A two-year-old aframax owned by Overseas Shipholding Group (OSG) was among 19 foreign vessels detained in UK ports during February for failing port-state-control safety inspections. Inspectors detained the 110,920-dwt **OVERSEAS SHIRLEY** (built 2001) with a fracture of main deck plating on February 10 at Sullom Voe, according to a report from the Maritime & Coastguard Agency (MCA). The tanker was detained for four days before being released for a single voyage to a repair yard, officials said. The Hyundai-built vessel is registered in the Marshall Islands and classed by the American Bureau of Shipping (ABS). It had no previous detentions or deficiencies, according to the Equasis database. OSG officials in New York were not immediately available for comment. Overseas Shirley was one of two tankers running afoul of inspectors at Sullom Voe.
