2005: Swire Shipping is pleased to announce the launch of its new service, Indotrans Asia. Indotrans Asia will provide a multipurpose breakbulk and containerised service linking South East Asia and Papua New Guinea to the Pacific Islands and key ports on the west coast of Canada and the USA.

The service will operate a fleet of three sister vessels, the PACIFIC ADVENTURER, **PACIFIC EXPLORER** & PACIFIC VOYAGER, on a 30 day frequency. All three ships are modern **23,737 dwt, high specification multipurpose, geared tweendeckers** with an 18.5-knot service speed.
