GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

Tanker **PACIFIC ONYX** (25,060 gross tonnage, built 1988, ex-ASTROLABE 1994) has been a familiar sight around New Zealand ports for several years, discharging oil products from Marsden Point or Australia, or loading export oil from the Maui B FPSO (Floating Production, Storage, Offloading tanker). Her charter ended in September 2003 and Shell's chartered HAMINEA (28,277 gross tonnage, built 1994), which made her first New Zealand port calls under the new charter during early October 2003, replaced her. **PACIFIC ONYX** sailed from New Plymouth for the last time on 27th September bound direct for Geelong after discharging petrol and loading Maui condensate and Taranaki crude oil. She made 180 ports calls at New Plymouth during the course of her charter and first called there in June 1995.
