CMA CGM snaps up 'Mipo 2800' tonnage

CMA CGM has purchased two 2,826 teu 'Hyundai 2800 Mipo' type container vessels, the 2005-built ISEACO HORIZON and the 2006-built IRENES RESPECT for a reported price of around USD 42 M per vessel.

The ISEACO HORIZON, bought from Singapore-based Iseaco Holdings is currently on charter to Wan Hai Lines while the IRENES RESPECT, acquired from Tsakos Shipping and Trading of Greece is performing an employment in the Middle East for ADNATCO. The ISEACO HORIZON and IRENES RESPECT were both built by South Korea's Hyundai Mipo shipyard in Ulsan. They had originally been ordered by German owner Reederei Thomas Schulte, who was trading them as the TATIANA SCHULTE and PATRICIA SCHULTE
