Being chartered by Senator Lines, Bremen, for eight years these vessels are employed in the Pacific South Pendulum II Service with a round voyage duration of about 86 days. This 4.545 TEU container vessel and her eight sisters are the largest containervessels of the new, modern fleet of Reederei F. Laeisz.

DSR-Senator Lines is beginning its service transfer from Bremerhaven, Germany, to Hamburg, Germany. The **PUSAN SENATOR** (operated by DSR-Senator Lines), on charter from Norddeutsche Vermoegensanlage GmbH & Co., made its first call at the Eurokai Terminal in Hamburg on 7/8/1997.

The MSC's FE-Mexico-USEC service is now fully upgraded to the maxi-panamax 4,800-5,000 teu scale with the phasingin this week of the 4,800 teu MSC KENYA, replacing the 4,396 teu MSC MATILDE. This service is ensured with nine ships. The Laeisz-owned MSC KENYA (alias PUSAN) has been taken in charge last week by MSC.. This ship spent almost ten years with DSR Senator / Senator Linie / Hanjin as **PUSAN SENATOR** (see below). The PUSAN belongs to a series of ten ships built in 1997-98 by Hyundai, based on a Bremer Vulkan design (BV 4500). All ten were chartered to DSR-Senator (which became Senator Linie in 2000) and Choyang Line (bankrupted in 2001 - the ships were re-chartered by Senator) (Senator and Choyang operated within a same alliance).
