The Hyper Galax service, operated in consortium with Emirates Shipping Line and TS Lines, ensures direct connection between Xingang, Qingdao, Shanghai, Ningbo, Hong Kong, Port Klang with Colombo, Cochin, Nhava Sheva, Dubai, Dammam and Abu Dhabi. SCI provides one vessel, m. v. **SCI DIYA**, to this 42-day service, which is being operated with 6 ships of 2,700 TEUs capacity each.

The `ISE` service is a Joint Service with five (5) partners, namely, SCI, ZIM Israel, Yang-Ming Lines of Taiwan, MISC of Malaysia and K-Line of Japan. It is a weekly service connecting JNP to Felixstowe in the shortest transit duration of eighteen (18) days. Its is a weekly service with round voyage time of 49 days.

The port rotation for `ISE` service is as follows:

Colombo - JNP - PortSaid - Barcelona - Felixstowe - Rotterdam - Hamburg - Port Said - Colombo

The Shipping Corporation of India (S.C. India) confirmed the introduction of its two 4,400 teu newbuildings SCI CHENNAI and SCI MUMBAI on the Indian Subcontinent Europe Service (ISES / ISC), operated in partnership with K Line, Yang Ming Line, MISC Bhd and Zim. They will replace in end December the chartered 3,091 teu **SCI DIYA** (alias WIDUKIND) and the 2,741 teu SCI JYOTI (alias STADT ROSTOCK).

SCI is then understood to send the **SCI DIYA** and SCI JYOTI on its Far East-India services for temporary assignments (filling gaps left by ships having to be sent in routine maintenance), either the INDFEX 1 or INDFEX 2, operated jointly with K Line and PIL.
