2009: AP-Moller Maersk is shifting nine containerships to US-flag arm Maersk Line Limited (MLL) as older ships exit a government

transport program, company spokesman said Friday. Four of the vessels are being re-flagged from the UK flag, while another five will come from elsewhere in Maersk's fleet. The ships will be added to the US Maritime Association (Marad) Maritime Security Program, a US-flag fleet of privately owned vessels qualified for carrying military cargoes. Norfolk, Virginia-based MLL operated 19 of 69 vessels in the program as of Marad's last count. The four vessels from the UK flag, which are being renamed after US states, are the 4,340-teu MAERSK KENTUCKY (EX-GLASGOW MAERSK, built 1999) and MAERSK WISCONSIN (EX-GREENWICH MAERSK, built 2000), the 4,150-teu MAERSK UTAH (EX-MAERSK GLOUCESTER, built 2006) and the 4,300-teu MAERSK IDAHO (EX-GOSPORT MAERSK, built 2000). The 4,080-teu SEA-LAND EAGLE (built 1997) and SEA-LAND MERCURY (built 1995) and the shifted from the Hong Kong to US flag, while **the 4,080-teu SEA-LAND CHAMPION shifted from the Dutch flag**. OEL buys a 4,360 teu vessel

Dubai-based Orient Express Lines (OEL) has acquired the 4,360 teu panamax SEA-LAND CHAMPION from an affiliate of the APM-Maersk Group. The vessel has been renamed OEL KHALEEJ EXPRESS and becomes OEL's largest-ever containership. The ship is to be deployed on OEL services covering the Middle East and India trades. The largest OEL vessel so far was the 3,606 teu OEL EMIRATES (ex NORFOLK EXPRESS), which OEL acquired from Hapag-Lloyd in April 2015.

The SEA-LAND CHAMPION is the first in a nine-ship series built in Japan in 1995-97 for the former Sea-Land Service, which had ordered them in 1994. The nine ships went under Maersk's control when the APM-Maersk Group purchased the international activities of Sea-Land in 1999, merged within the Maersk Line containership business to become Maersk Sealand.

Finally, the 4,360-teu panamax *Sea-Land Champion* (built 1995) has been sold and is likely to become the largest containership in the fleet of Indian operator Orient Express Lines (OEL). The vessel is owned by the Maersk Group, which appears intent on getting rid of a growing number of panamax boxships,

<u>2017:</u>

Panamaxes account for a majority of the ships to be removed, cumulating 16 units of 4,000-5,000 teu. This includes eight 4,360 teu ships of the SEA-LAND COMET series built in 1995-96 that were sold for scrap by Maersk in December last year. The first of them, the SEA-LAND INTREPID, arrived in Jiangyin (China) on 15 January. A ninth unit in this series, the former SEA-LAND CHAMPION sold in April 2016 by Maersk to Orient Express Lines and renamed OEL KHALEEJ EXPRESS, has also been sold for scrap by its new owner. The vessel arrived at Gadani (Pakistan) this week for beaching.
