VANSHIP Holdings, the bulker company jointly owned by Univan's Charles Vandeperre and Shinyo International's Fred Cheng, has sold its entire fleet of nine tankers to US-listed Energy Infrastructure Acquisition Corp for \$778m.

All nine ships are on long-term charter to Asian charterers including firms in South Korea, Taiwan and China such as South Korea's SK Shipping and Taiwan's Formosa group. All will remain on charter for an average length of 6.3 years at rates of between \$28,900 and \$43,800 per day. The vessels, which are all flagged in Hong Kong, are likely to remain flagged in the territory, while the vessels will be managed by Univan Shipmanagement.
