#### **GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:**

"SHUN XIN", was delivered from COSCO Zhoushan Shipyard on 27th February. This is the first 57,000DWT bulk carrier built for COSCO (Hong Kong) Shipping Co., Ltd. and is classed by NK. This was the fifth 57,000DWT bulk carrier to be delivered by COSCO Zhoushan Shipyard.

Named **'SHUN XIN**', the 57,000DWT bulker is the first of its type built for COSCO Shipping and is the fifth vessel of its design to have been constructed at Zhoushan. Designed by the Shanghai Merchant Ship Research & Design Institute (SDARI) and built to NK classification standards, the all-steel vessel has an overall length of 189.99 metres, a beam of 32.26 metres and a depth to main deck of 18 metres. Total deadweight capacity is 57,000 tonnes. The hull is arranged with five independent cargo holds with a total cargo capacity of 71,500m3. Four 30 tonne capacity deck cranes are installed for cargo handling.

Propulsion is provided by a single MAN B&W 6S50MC-C main engine, outputting 9,480kW for a cruising speed of 14.2 knots. Auxiliary power needs are met by three Taiyo FE 547A-8 generators, each with an output of 600kW. Total fuel capacity is 2,200m3 giving '**SHUN XIN**' a range of over 18,000 nautical miles at a cruising fuel consumption of around 30.4 tonnes per day.

Registered in Panama, and flying that country's flag, 'SHUN XIN' operates with a 26-person crew.
