#### Gemadept buys SINAR BROMO (1,054 teu)

Gemadept Shipping, the liner shipping division of Vietnam's Gemadept Corporation has purchased the 1,054 teu SINAR BROMO (Hakata 1000) from Japanese interests that were chartering the vessel to Indonesia's Samudera. The vessel has been renamed PRIDE PACIFIC under Vietnamese flag.

The SINAR BROMO was built in 2009 by Japan's Hakata Zosen shipyard. She belongs to the 'Hakata 1000' type, of which 20 vessels were built from 1997 to 2015. She has a dwt of 15,210 tons, an Loa of 147 m and a beam of 25 m. This is the second time Gemadept purchased a 'Hakata 1000' type vessel in recent times, having already acquired in October 2017 the sister vessel SINAR BUTON which it renamed GREEN PACIFIC.

The PRIDE PACIFIC and GREEN PACIFIC are today the biggest container vessels controlled by Gemadept, who also owns and operates three significantly smaller containerships, the 848 teu PACIFIC GRACE, the 749 teu PACIFIC EXPRESS and the 699 teu PACIFIC PEARL. Gemadept's ocean going container tonnage is deployed either on domestic routes in Vietnam, or on international services connecting Vietnam to Singapore, Hong Kong and mainland China.

Gemadept Shipping is the container shipping arm of Vietnam's Gemadept Corp, a multi-faceted conglomerate involved in shipping & logistics, port operations, real estate and rubber plantations. In addition to ocean shipping, Gemadept also runs a network of inland barges on the Mekong River. Of note, South Korea's CJ Logistics Group took a 49% stake in Gemadept Shipping in October 2017.
