At the Qingshan Shipyard in Wuhan, on the Yangtze River in inland China, four all-electric chemical tankers are being built for the UK coastal tanker operator F.T.Everard & Sons. The first tanker, named SPECIALITY, will be delivered at the end of this year with the other tankers following at approximately six monthly intervals. The same customer also has an option on further deliveries of two additional tankers.

Singapore's FSL Trust has sealed the refinancing of five product tankers with a Taiwanese financial institution.

The trust has refinanced *Cumbrian Fisher*, *Clyde Fisher*, *Shannon Fisher*, *Solway Fisher*, *Seniority* and *Superiority* in a deal which sees FSL receive \$15m under the new five-year loan.

## FSL secures pair of long-term charter extensions

First Ship Leasing Trust (FSL Trust) has sealed long-term charter extensions with UK-based James Fisher Everard for two tankers.

The Singapore-listed product tanker owner has fixed the 2005-built *Clyde Fisher* and the 2006-built *Speciality* for two and three years, respectively.

The trust has eight tankers of different sizes in its portfolio, all of which are employed under fixed-rate period charters to James Fisher Everard with contracted revenue of \$25.6m as of December 31, 2022.
