### **GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:**

17 Nov 1987 left Lyttelton for Wellington as usual, but had a crankcase explosion 20 miles North of Godley Head, resulting in a seized piston on her main engine. Lyttelton tug PURAU took her in tow and she returned to port. She was back in service 4 days later.

Aug 1998 Pacifica Shipping changed their ships **SPIRIT OF COMPETITION**, SPIRIT OF FREEDOM and SPIRIT OF VISION from the New Zealand flag and registed them at St. Johns, Antigua and Barbuda. It was later revealed that Pacifica had sold the 3 ships to overseas interests and was operating them on a lease-back arrangement. www.nzmaritimeindex.org.nz

Mar 2000 the owner of Pacifica's chartered vessels placed its three RoRo vessels SPIRIT OF VISION, SPIRIT OF FREEDOM and **SPIRIT OF COMPETITION** up for sale. It was keen to replace the ships with larger RoRo vessels with a greater capacity for containers.
